Oliver Meier is currently a Systems Engineer working in the Product Development group at Boeing Commercial Airplanes (BCA). His primary responsibilities include cargo and crew rest fire protection development for new and derivative airplane programs and is the Principle Investigator for BCA's Halon-free cargo fire suppression research and development program.
