Presenter Biography: Bob McKnight is the Acting Project Manager for NASA's Accident Mitigation Project. He holds B.S. and M.S. degrees in engineering and, prior to joining NASA, Mr. McKnight was a product engineer for the BF Goodrich Co.'s Aircraft Ice Protection Systems unit. He also holds an FAA Airline Transport Pilot certificate and Air Force Command Pilot ratings and has accrued over 10,000 hours of flight experience in numerous types of civil and military air transport aircraft. Since coming to NASA Glenn in 1982, he has served as a research pilot for conducting studies of in-flight icing, remote sensing, and microgravity effects; and managed various aeronautical research projects, such as the AGATE program's Propulsion Sensors & Controls, and Ice Protection Systems areas. Mr. McKnight has been with the Accident Mitigation project since mid 2000.
