

Mac McLean, Ph.D.

Dr. Mac McLean is an Engineering Bio-Psychologist with the Protection and Survival Research Laboratory at the FAA Civil Aerospace Medical Institute and an adjunct faculty member in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at the Oklahoma University Health Sciences Center. His research activities over the last 2 decades have centered on studies of aircraft emergencies, aircraft emergency evacuations, and post-crash survival, resulting in over 100 scientific publications and presentations. Mac has served on numerous aviation standards writing bodies dedicated to improvements in transport airplane design and operation, and has consulted nationally and internationally toward the development of aircraft escape systems, emergency and protective equipment, and emergency procedures for civil and military aviation.
