Joseph Allen is a Senior Scientist with Environmental Health & Engineering, Inc. and Research Associate at the Harvard School of Public Health. He earned a doctorate in environmental health and a master's degree in public health from Boston University. Dr. Allen concentrates his practice on exposure science, statistical analysis of environmental and occupational data, and environmental epidemiology. He is a frequent author and speaker on environmental health topics in scientific journals and meetings, and was recently invited to be a panelist at two international forums - *Modern Chemicals & Modern Diseases* (at Indoor Air, Copenhagen, Denmark) and *Trends in Environmental Risk* (at International Consumer Product Health and Safety Organization, Washington, DC, USA). He has directed community and occupational exposure assessments related to a broad class of environmental health topics including flame retardants, persistent organic compounds, VOCs, heavy metals, air pollution, and infectious disease outbreaks. Dr. Allen also holds an academic appointment at Brandeis University.
