- •The FAA has requested that ISO (the International Organization for Standardization) develop a standard for Fire Containment Covers (FCC's).
- •At least four working group meetings have been conducted to develop the standard.
- •The standard is still in draft form and the details are copyright protected.
- •Participation in the working group has included EASA, FAA, Airbus, Boeing, FedEx, UPS, SATCO, and others.
- •The overall objective of the FAA is to revise TSO-C90d and reference the ISO standard as a requirement.
- •There has been discussion on developing other ISO Standard to apply to fire resistant ULD's.
